BED BUG PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow these instructions prior to the scheduled appointment for the treatment of bed bugs. If the room(s) to be treated are not prepared for treatment according to these instructions, our technician has the authority and reserves the right to cancel the treatment. The appointment will, then, need to be rescheduled once all preparations are complete.

1. Remove all bedding from the bed.
 - a. Wash all sheets, pillow covers, window drapes and curtains and blankets in hot water, dry on high heat prior to treatment.
 - b. Do not return any washed material back to the infested area until after the treatment.
2. Remove everything from under the beds.
3. Remove box spring and mattress from the bed frame and stand them up against the wall for treatment.
4. Remove all picture frames, curtains and anything else from the walls.
5. Sweep or vacuum floors within the infested area.
6. Clear all belongings from the tops of dressers, tables and any other furniture within the affected rooms.
7. Do not remove anything from the closets or take anything out of the drawers.

Any new, untreated furniture or belongings brought into the room AFTER TREATMENT voids the warranty. You must call the office at (979) 846-2009 to have the items treated (an additional cost applies), or the warranty. Repainting the room or removing/replacing carpet in a room after the treatment will void any warranty.

You may notice bed bug activity within 25 days after treatment. This activity is normal. Please allow 25 days after treatment before calling for a follow up inspection as this time is needed for the product to work.
